

## The File-Code Structure for SmD Teaching Material

Principles: Each file has a specific code number at the beginning of the file name. This code gives a unique identification for the file to which subject the content belongs. The code exists of:

### First three positions (Letters):

Label: SmD (Science meets Dharma, the project name under which all files have been written)

### Forth position (letter):

Main subject of science:

**I:** Introduction  
**M:** Mathematics  
**P:** Physics  
**C:** Chemistry  
**B:** Biology (Life sciences)  
**E:** Earth and Space Sciences  
 Astronomy  
 Archaeology  
 Ecology and Environment  
 Geography  
 Geology  
 Meteorology

### Fifth position (letter):

Content

**S:** Script  
**E:** Exercises/Laboratory/Practical  
**T:** Test  
**P:** Pictures, Presentation, Movies, Media,  
**V:** Various

### Sixth and seventh positions (number)

Consecutive numbers for files of the same subject and content

### Eights position: underscore

### Ninth position and further:

Keywords of file content followed by an underscore, then language(s), underscore again, followed by the name of the author, if available. Finally, the file extension is indicated after a dot.
